### **Academic Search Premier**

Academic collection of full text, peer-reviewed journals. Nearly 4,700 journals are available in full text, and more than 3,600 of these are peer-reviewed. Provides full text coverage for a broad array of subject areas, including biology, chemistry, engineering, physics, psychology, and religion & theology.

### **AGRICOLA**

Compiled by the U.S. National Agricultural Library (NAL), this database consists of citations to journal articles, monographs, theses, patents, software, audio-visual materials, and technical reports.

### **Alt Health Watch**

Collection of perspectives of complementary, holistic and integrated approaches to health care and wellness. Includes hundreds of pamphlets, booklets, special reports, original research and book excerpts.

### **Bibliography of Native North Americans**

Covers all aspects of native North American culture, history, and life. Contains citations for books, essays, journal articles, and government documents of the United States and Canada. Dates of coverage for included content range from the sixteenth century to the present.

### **Book Collection: Nonfiction**

This database contains informative abstracts and searchable full text for more than 2,100 popular nonfiction books, including full text entries on core subject areas, as well as information on careers, health, sports, adventure, technology, life skills and more. School level.

### **Wilson Biographies Plus Illustrated**

Encompasses biographical coverage from a host of high quality Wilson biographical resources, including Current Biography, the World Authors Series, and the Junior Authors & Illustrators series. In addition, Wilson Biographies Plus Illustrated includes over 80,000 profiles licensed from a number of respected reference publishers.

### **Business Source Complete**

Offers coverage of such topics as accounting, banking, finance, international business, management, marketing, real estate, regional studies, sales, trade and technology.

### **Computer Science Index**

Focuses on subjects such as artificial intelligence, expert systems, system design, data structures, computer theory, computer systems and architecture, software engineering, human-computer interaction, new technologies, social and professional context, and much more. Coverage back to the mid 1960s.

### **Computer Source**

Provides researchers with the latest information and current trends in high technology. Includes full text journals such as AI Communications, Applied Artificial Intelligence, Computer Science Education, Cybernetics & Systems, Electromagnetics, Expert Systems, Information Systems Research, International Journal of Computational Engineering Science.

### **Consumer Health Complete**

Resource for consumer-oriented health content. It is designed to support patients' information needs and foster an overall understanding of health-related topics. This full text database covers topics such as aging, cancer, diabetes, drugs & alcohol, fitness, nutrition & dietetics, children's health, men & women's health, etc.

### **Credo Reference**

This is a completely customizable general reference solution for learners and librarians. Its full-text, aggregated content covers every major subject from the world's best publishers of reference.

### **EBSCO Animals**

Provides thousands of easy-to-read entries about mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish, dinosaurs and prehistoric animals. Each entry begins with a simple category breakdown of the animal including Kingdom, Class, Order, Genus & Species, and Geographical Locale.

### **Economia y Negocios**

Provides coverage for over 200 Spanish and Portuguese-language periodicals published in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Spain, the United States and elsewhere dating back to the early 1980s. Tool for research conducted in the areas of business and economics.

### **ERIC**

The Education Resources Information Center (ERIC) is a digital library of education-related resources. The ERIC database contains abstracts of documents and journal articles on education research and practice.

### **Environment Complete**

Contains all of the content available in Environment Index, as well as full text for 400 journals, including many of the most used journals in the discipline, such as Environment (back to 1975), Ecologist, Conservation Biology, etc. Also provides full text for 80 monographs, such as Encyclopedia of World Environmental History (3 volumes).

### **Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia**

This database provides over 25,000 encyclopedic entries covering a variety of subject areas.

### **Garden, Landscape & Horticulture Index**

Resource for access to articles about gardens and plants. Topics include horticulture, botany, garden and landscape design & history, ecology, plant and garden conservation, garden management, and horticultural therapy. A highlight of the database is its focus on environmentally sustainable horticultural and design.

### **General Science Collection**

Offers full text coverage for more than 60 of the most popular science publications. Subject areas covered include the observation, description, identification, and experimental investigation of phenomena, and the application of science to industrial or commercial objectives.

### **GreenFILE**

Offers well-researched information covering all aspects of human impact to the environment. Its collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles includes content on global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling, and more. The database provides indexing and abstracts for approximately 295,000 records, as well as Open Access full text for more than 4,600 records.

### **Health Source:Nursing/Academic Edition**

Contains scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Coverage of nursing and allied health is particularly strong. Includes Clinical Pharmacology, which provides access to clinically relevant drug monographs for all U.S. prescription drugs, hard-to-find herbal and nutritional supplements, over-the-counter products and new drugs. Full text information in this database dates as far back as 1975.

### **History Reference Center**

Full text history reference database that includes reference books, encyclopedias, non-fiction books, and history periodicals. Contains historical documents, biographies of historical figures, historical photos and maps, and historical film and video.

### **Hospitality & Tourism Index Complete**

Scholarly research and industry news relating to all areas of hospitality and tourism. Subject areas covered include the culinary arts, demographics & statistics, development & investment, food & beverage management, hospitality law, hotel management & administrative practices, leisure & business travel, market trends, technology and more.

### **Humanities International Complete**

Provides indexing, abstracting, and full text of journals, books and other important reference sources in the humanities. Includes citations and abstracts for articles, essays and reviews, as well as original creative works including poems, fiction, photographs, paintings and illustrations.

### **Information Science & Technology Abstracts**

Provides full text of journal articles and indexing of books, research reports and conference proceedings. Subject coverage includes librarianship, classification, cataloging, bibliometrics, online information retrieval, information management, search engines, printed and electronic information sources, the information industry, scholarly communication, and electronic publishing.

### **Insurance Periodicals Index**

Indexes and abstracts over 200 of the most respected and widely-read insurance industry journals and magazines, including the Journal of Risk and Insurance, and the Journal of Risk and Uncertainty. IPI serves as a valuable addition to EBSCO's business coverage, and will interest researchers in economics, social scientists, and insurance and government organizations.

### **International Bibliography of Theatre & Dance**

The definitive research tool for the study of theatre and the performing arts.

### **Internet and Personal Computing Abstracts**

Citations and abstracts to literature in popular and professional computing magazines, including news, product and vendor guides, and reviews of software, hardware and books. Internet & Personal Computing Abstracts is searchable by keyword, author, title, company or product name, programming language, and several other criteria.

### **Kids Resource Center**

Online resources for grades K-5.

### **Legal Collection**

Collection of respected, scholarly peer-reviewed publications including law journals, documents, and case studies. Provides information centered on the discipline of law and legal topics such as criminal justice, international law, federal law, organized crime, medical, labor & human resource law, ethics, the environment and more.

### **Literary Reference Center**

Provides a broad spectrum of information on thousands of authors and their works across literary disciplines and timeframes. Includes full text of selected classic and contemporary poems and short stories along with full text of a number of literary encyclopedia and guides.

### **MAS Ultra - School Edition**

Covers general reference, health, science, and other areas. Full text is also available for many biographies and primary source documents, pamphlets, reference books (including the Columbia Encyclopedia, the CIA World Fact Book and World Almanac & Book of Facts), and an Image Collection of 91,000 photos, maps & flags.

### **MasterFILE Premier**

Provides full text plus indexing of popular magazines on topics such as general reference, business, consumer health, general science, and multi-cultural periodicals. Contains full text for reference and travel books; biographies; primary source documents; and an image collage of photos, maps, and flags.

### **Middle Search Plus**

Contains full text for 140 popular, middle school magazines. All full text articles are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles). Full text is also available for thousands of biographies and historical essays. Additionally, Middle Search Plus contains primary source documents including Essential Documents in American History, reference books including the Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia and American Heritage Dictionary, 4th Edition from Houghton Mifflin, the Encyclopedia of Animals, and an Image Collection of 235,186 photos, maps and flags.

### **Natural & Alternative Treatments**

Alternative medicine database designed specifically for the consumer-health researcher. Also contains detailed, evidence-based information on herbs and supplements, functional foods, and other alternative therapies such as acupuncture and homeopathy. And provides comprehensive information on drug/herb/supplement interactions.

### **Newspaper Source**

Contains selected full text from newspapers. This database also contains indexing and abstracts for four national newspapers.

### **NoveList**

Reader's advisory. Locates books for general reading, users can learn more about particular books and authors through Author Read-alikes, Feature Articles, Book Discussion Guides, and BookTalks. Offers support for librarians, teachers, and individual readers. Contains material related to picture books, children's "chapter" books, young adult titles, and books for adults.

### **Primary Search**

Contains full text for nearly 70 popular, elementary school magazines. All full text articles are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles). Additionally, Primary Search includes the Encyclopedia of Animals™, and features the Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia, which provides students with easy-to-read encyclopedic entries written specifically for kids. This database also provides the American Heritage® Children's Dictionary, 3rd Edition from Houghton Mifflin, and an Image Collection of 285,912 photos, maps and flags.

### **Professional Development Collection**

Collection of magazine, journal, and newspaper articles published on topics useful for education professionals. Includes abstracts and indexing along with some full-text.

### **Psychology & Behavioral Sciences Collection**

Comprehensive database that covers information concerning topics in emotional and behavioral characteristics, psychiatry & psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and observational and experimental methods.

### **Regional Business News**

Regional Business News incorporates business journals, newspapers and newswires covering all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States.

### **Religion & Philosophy Collection**

Comprehensive database covering topics such as world religions, major denominations, biblical studies, religious history, epistemology, political philosophy, philosophy of language, moral philosophy and the history of philosophy.

### **Serials Directory**

Provides access to the most up-to-date and accurate bibliographic information as well as current pricing structures for popular serials. Updated quarterly.

### **Student Resource Center**

Online resources for grades 6-12.

### **Teacher Reference Center**

Indexes titles from the most popular teacher and administrator trade journals, periodicals, and books. This database provides coverage on key education topics such as Assessment, Continuing Education, Current Pedagogical Research, Curriculum Development, Instructional Media, Language Arts, Literacy Standards, Science & Mathematics, and more.

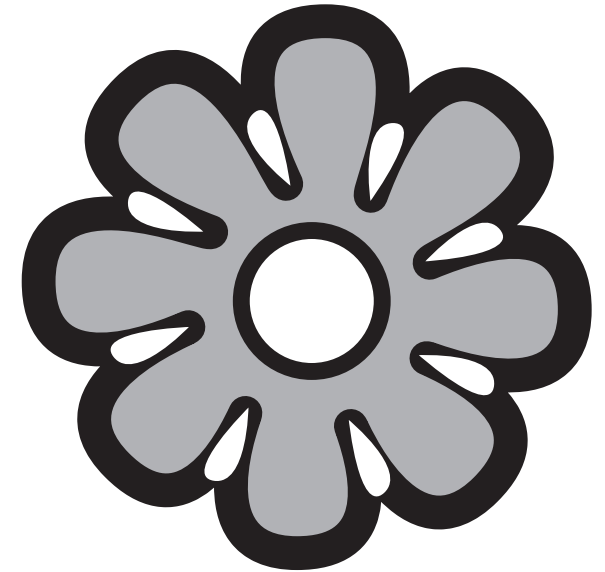
### **TOPICsearch**
